Check List

To issue an EMD-S you need the:

1. End transact booking file
2. Issue ticket
3. SVC-segment

EMD Issuance

Issue the EMD

EMDI/Pn/IC*ticketnumber*/Rx

where n is the passenger number, optional RFIC selector with x as the RFIC letter

Issue the EMD with an exchange

EMDI/Pn/IC*ticketnumber*/EXE*existingEMDnumber*

Notes

What are the different EMD types?

1. EMD-S (Stand Alone) - can be used for any service or fee, i.e. lounge access, change fees, group deposits; - items that are not tied or directly related to a specific flight segment
2. EMD-A (Associated) - will be used for flight related services i.e. seats, bags, meals - associated directly with a specific flight segment.

Void/Refund

Void the EMD: EMDVe

Where e is the EMD number.

This entry can only be used within the same day the EMD is issued

Refund the EMD: from the EMDD display, insert F on the refund line.

This entry can only be used if the EMD is refundable.
