Exchange Rates

The average UATP exchange rate was in 2004

Note

- While AMEX, MasterCard or Visa use their own exchange rates, UATP uses the neutral Reuters rate.
- The UATP exchange rate is used for the conversion of sales currency into account currently (if different).

Refund

Same refund process as with any credit card:

- Issue the refund via your usual business process
- 2. BSP processes the refund
- 3. You will receive the refunded amount on your HR e-Payment Account
